On the contrary - several outstanding scientists, such as Albert Einstein or Thomas Edison, were dyslexics.

Strain on Parents and Children

Reading and writing disabilities can prove to be a huge burden on the children and parents. The gap between the child's classmates grows larger over the years and the child's motivation to learn lessens with every failure. The more efficiently and earlier dyslexia is treated, the higher the child's motivation to learn remains. By training with Dybuster on their own, while still supervised and controlled, children recognize their own progress and their enjoyment to learn is strengthened.
